| MSW/WO replacement Preference Assessment | Place stimuli in a randomly sequences straight line | Y/ N | MSW *replace the selected item in the array MSWO *remove the selected item from the array | Y/ N |
| | Instruct the child to select 1 and allow access for up to 30-seconds | Y/ N | Rotate stimuli placement | Y/ N |
